Dear Councillor Fathers,

Thank you for reaching out and for sharing your concerns regarding Marlborough Public School.

Marlborough has served generations of students and families in West Windsor and is an important part of the history and identity of the neighbourhood. In my view, its heritage and community value should be given serious consideration in determining its future.

I support making every reasonable effort to preserve and modernize Marlborough while ensuring that students have a safe, accessible and high-quality learning environment. Rehabilitation, modernization, adaptive reuse and other alternatives should be carefully examined alongside the heritage value of the building and the educational needs of students.

I would not support demolishing an important heritage and community asset simply for a possible future project. If demolition is ultimately proposed, the Board should clearly demonstrate why it is necessary, what alternatives have been considered, the comparative costs and educational benefits, and how the proposal fits within the Board's long-term capital plan.

You also raise important questions about equity in capital investment, programming and specialized services in West Windsor. I believe these questions deserve careful examination. Board resources should be allocated using transparent and equitable criteria, taking into account enrolment, facility conditions, educational needs and the social and economic circumstances of the communities being served.

I would also encourage the City of Windsor and the Greater Essex County District School Board to work collaboratively to determine whether the educational, financial, community and heritage objectives can be addressed together.

As a trustee, my responsibility would be to listen to residents and school communities, examine the evidence, ask questions of administration, and make decisions transparently and in the best interests of students and the public school system.

Thank you for bringing this important matter forward.
